- Denotes 1/2 inch iron pipe tagged L.S.3570, and set on this survey.
- Denotes 1/2 inch steel rod tagged L.S.2902, and found on this survey.
- Denotes 3/4 inch steel rod tagged L.S.2902, and found on this survey.
- Denotes 1/2 inch steel rod tagged R.C.E.10761, and found on this survey.
- === Denotes a 5 foot public utility easement along each side and rear lot lines, and a 10 foot public utility easement adjacent to the boundary.

The meridian of this survey is identical with the meridian of "SIERRA HIGHLANDS SUBDIVISION UNIT NO. 1", a map of which is on file in the office of the Recorder of Amador County in Book 1 of Subdivision Maps at page 33.
