## Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick®

### Urban Granny Dog Sweater

Pattern Number: 80932AD

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** Small, Medium, Large, 1X

**Finished Chest** 11 1/4 (19 1/2, 25 1/2, 30 1/2) in. [28.5 (49.5, 65, 77.5) cm]

**Finished Length** 10 1/2 (17, 22 1/2, 27 1/2) in. [26.5 (43, 57, 70) cm]

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

#### MATERIALS

- 640-136 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick Yarn: Apricot  
1 (1, 1, 2) Ball (A)
- 640-178 Lion Brand Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick Yarn: Cilantro  
1 (1, 1, 2) Ball (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size P-15
- Large-Eyed Blunt Needles

#### GAUGE:

6 hdc + 5 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### DOG SWEATER

##### BACK

With A, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

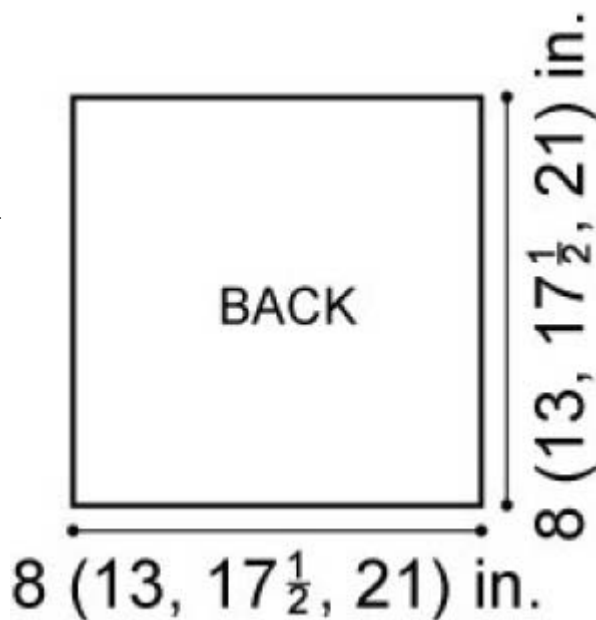
**Rnd 1:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in ring, \*ch 2, 2 hdc in ring; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 2; join B with sl st in top of beg ch.

**Rnd 2:** Sl st to first ch-2 sp, ch 2 (counts as hdc here and throughout), hdc in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 2, 2 hdc in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, 2 hdc in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 2, 2 hdc in same ch-2 sp, ch 1; join A with sl st in top of beg ch.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st to first ch-2 sp, ch 2, hdc in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 2, 2 hdc in same ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 2 hdc in next ch-sp) 2 times; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 2, 2 hdc in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, 2 hdc in next ch-sp, ch 1; join B with sl st in top of beg ch.

**Rnd 4:** Sl st to first ch-2 sp, ch 2, hdc in same ch-2 sp, \*ch 2, 2 hdc in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, (2 hdc in next ch-sp, ch1) across to next ch-2 sp, 2 hdc in ch-2 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 2, 2 hdc in same ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 2 hdc in next ch-sp) across to beg ch, ch 1; join A with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rep last Rnd 1 (4, 7, 9) times. Fasten off.



## UNDERPIECE

Work as for Back for 2 (4, 5, 6) rnds. Do not fasten off.

### Neck

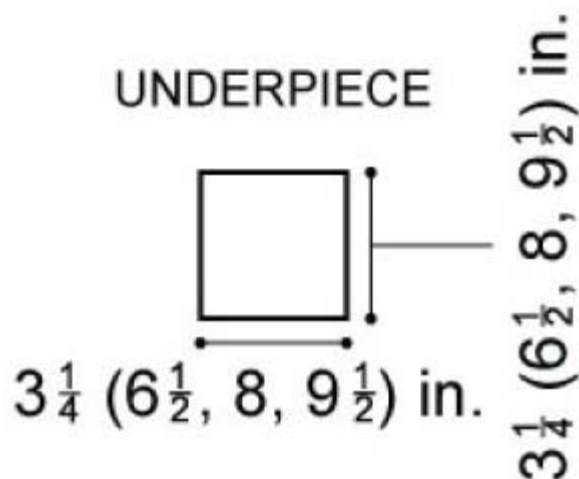
With A, Sl st to first ch-2 sp.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 2, hdc in each hdc and ch-sp on one edge of Underpiece, hdc in each hdc and ch-sp along one edge of Back; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 2, hdc in each hdc around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rep last rnd 1 (3, 4, 6) more times.

Fasten off.



## FINISHING

Sew sides of Underpiece to Back, leaving 3 (3 1/2, 4, 4 1/2) in. [7.5 (9, 10, 11.5) cm] open on each side for legs.
