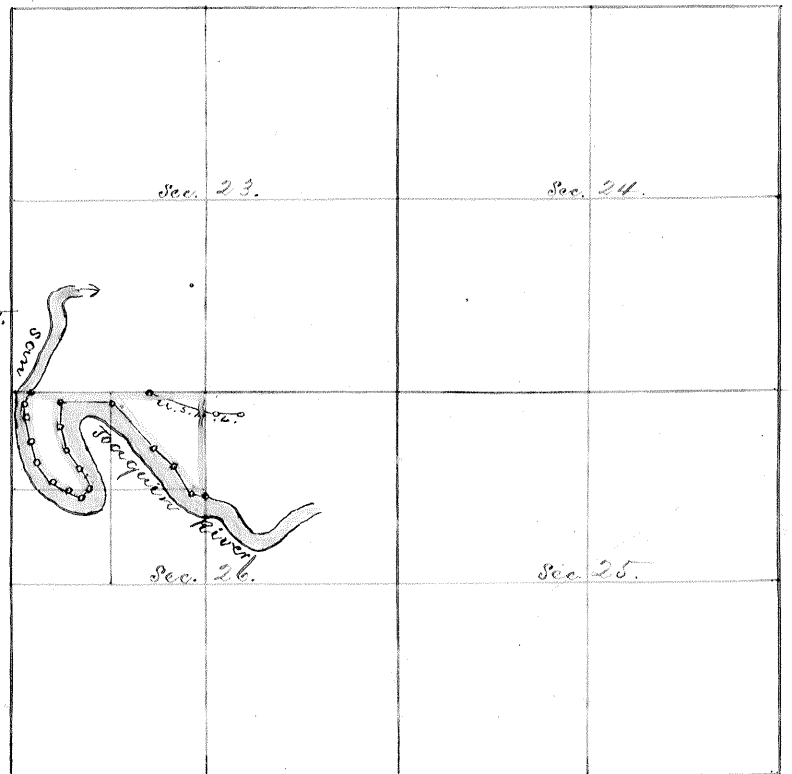

Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner on the East and West line between sections 23, and 26, in Downship 4 South, Range 7 East, Base and Meridian of Mount Diablo; Thence West 36.21 chains to a Post set at the intersection of said line with the right bank of the San Joaquin River; Thence ~~Wander~~ up Stream;— S $27\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W 24.0 chs; S 8° W 3.00 chs; S $11\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E 5.00 chs; S 18° E 4.00 chs; S 44° E 6.00 chs; S $58\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E 3.00 chs; S $78\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 3.50 chs; N $55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 1.50 chs; N 29° W 5.00 chs; N $40\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W 5.00 chs; N $4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W 5.00 chs; N 3.00° E 5.00 chs; East 11.00 chs; S $41\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 11.80 chs; S $51\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 5.00 chs; S 36° E 6.50 chs; S $73\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E 3.34 chs. to a Post set at intersection with the $\frac{1}{4}$ section line North and South, in Section 26; Thence North 20.65 chs. to the point of beginning;
