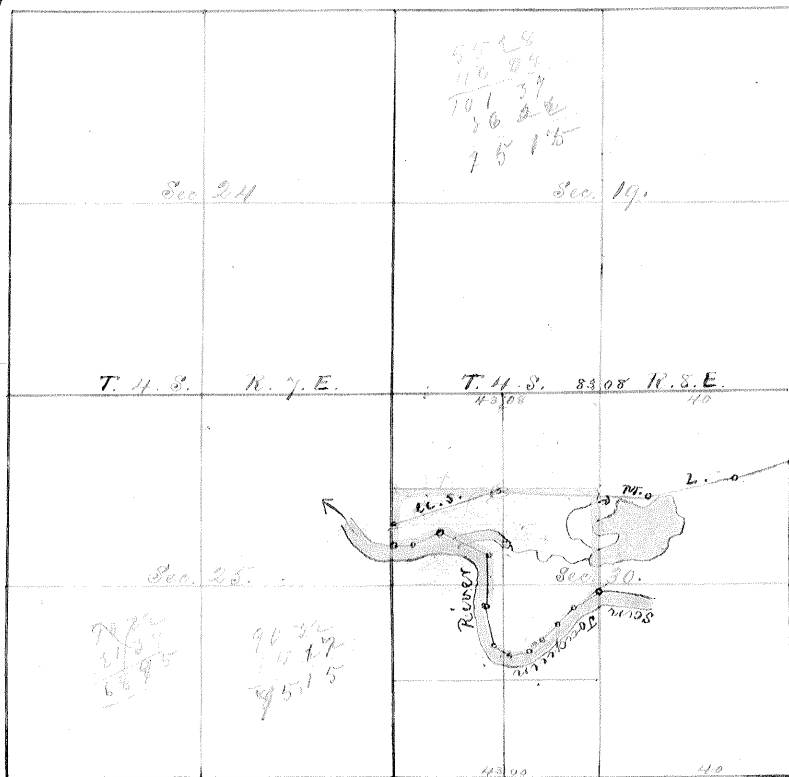

Field Notes

Beginning at a Post and Mound set on Range Line between Ranges 7 and 8 East, 20.00 chains South of the Corner of Sections 24, and 25, Township 4 South, Range 7 East, and Sections 19, and 30, Township 4 South, Range 8 East, Base and Meridian of Mount Diablo; Thence East 43.08 chains to a Post and Mound set at intersection with the $\frac{1}{4}$ section line North, and South, in Sec. 30; Thence South 21.37 chains to a Post set at intersection with the right bank of the San Joaquin River; from which a Willow Tree 4 inches in diameter bears $S 65\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ 9 links distant, and another Willow Tree 5 inches in diameter, bears $N 75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ 16 links distant; Thence down Stream:— $S 56\frac{1}{4}^{\circ} W$ 6.00 chains; $S 47^{\circ} W$ 3.00 chs; $S 37\frac{3}{4}^{\circ} W$ 4.50 chs; $S 51\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ 3.50 chs; $S 77\frac{3}{4}^{\circ} W$ 3.50 chs; $N 54\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ 4.00 chs; $N 11\frac{1}{4}^{\circ} W$ 8.00 chs; North 10.71 chs; $N 65^{\circ} W$ 10.75 chs; $S 67\frac{1}{4}^{\circ} W$ 7.00 chs; West 3.45 chs. to a Post set at intersection with the Township line between Ranges 7 and 8 East; from which a Willow Tree 4 feet in diameter bears $N 88\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ 1.34 chs. distant; Thence North 11.74 chs. to the point of Beginning.
Run by the true Meridian: Magnetic Variation $15^{\circ} 45'$ East.
